Athletes & Coaches Reach for Excellence...with BV Club Support

- ▶ Baseball team wins first outright Iowa Conference title since 1980 and wins first-ever tournament championship to earn an automatic berth into the NCAA Regional Tournament.
- ▶ Head baseball coach Steve Eddie was named IAC Coach of the Year and senior Brandon Pietrzyk was named IAC Position Player of the Year.
- ▶ Junior Morgan Darrow earned All-American Track and Field honors in the shot put at both the NCAA Indoor (8th place) & Outdoor (5th place) Championships.
- ▶ Senior Andy Soper became the first medalist for the men's golf team at the IAC Championships since 1985.
- ▶ Freshman wrestler Austin Mogg earned All-American honors at the NCAA Championships (5th place). Freshman Brian Broll was also a national qualifier.
- ▶ Senior Margo Muhlbauer was named the IAC MVP. She became the fourth women's basketball player in conference history to surpass 2,000 career points. She also earned All-American honors and was a Jostens Trophy Finalist.
- ▶ BVU had 32 academic all-conference selections in 2009-10.
- ▶ Softball team advances into first IAC Tournament since 2006.
