Athletes & Coaches Reach for Excellence...with BV Club Support

- ▶ 32 Buena Vista athletes earned IAC all-conference honors in 2008-09.
- ▶ Men's basketball player Andre Wagner was named the IAC MVP.
- ▶ Women's basketball player Margo Muhlbauer was named one of 10 finalists for the Josten's Trophy – given out to the nation's top player.
- ▶ Football team posts highest overall conference finish – second – since 1986. Head Coach Jay Anderson was named IAC Coach of the Year.
- ▶ 34 Buena Vista student-athletes earned IAC academic honors.
- ▶ Head men's golf coach Eric Wiebers was named IAC Co-Coach of the Year.
- ▶ Senior track & field athlete Eric Bertelsen won the national championship in the long jump at both the NCAA Indoor & Outdoor Championships. He also earned All-American honors in the 55-meter dash (indoor) and 100-meter dash (outdoor). Senior Shawn Olorundami also earned All-American accolades at both championships in the 110-meter hurdles.
- ▶ Bertelsen was named IAC MVP for both indoor and outdoor championships.
- ▶ Baseball tied the school record for wins in a season (27).
- ▶ Junior Brandon Pietrzyk was named Second Team All-American by D3baseball.com and by the American Baseball Coaches Association/Rawlings.
