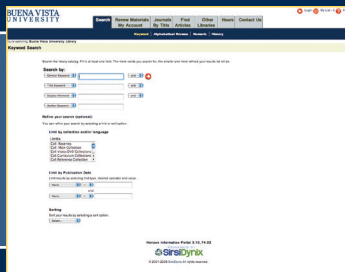

# IDENTIFYING RESOURCES

## CATALOG

Use the catalog to identify books, e-books, videos, CDs, DVDs, reference materials, curriculum materials, and journal subscriptions owned by the library. To access this database, enter search terms into the search box for the “BVU Catalog” located on the right-hand side of the Library homepage, then click “Search.” Remote users can request loans of circulating items via the “Request” button associated with each item. Access to the catalog does not require a login.

To access the library’s collections, type terms into the **CATALOG** search box on the library homepage.



**ELECTRONIC ACCESS** You can access the library’s electronic resources from any computer with an internet connection via the website.

## ARTICLES

The Library provides access to over 50 subscription databases—some of a general nature and others subject-specific. Many databases provide not only citations to articles, but include the complete text of the articles themselves, which can be e-mailed, downloaded, or printed. Due to licensing agreements, access to the library’s subscription databases is limited to currently enrolled students, staff, and faculty of BVU.



To access the databases, click the **FIND ARTICLES** link on the Library homepage.

## JOURNAL HOLDINGS

To identify journal, magazine, and newspaper titles that BVU makes available, either in print or electronically, click the “Journals by Title” link on the library homepage. Search by title, ISSN, or subject. Information for each title listed will specify coverage dates for that journal and format/availability. If a journal is available in print at the Storm Lake campus, it will indicate “Buena Vista University Print Holdings.” If a journal is available in a database, a link will be provided. After logging in, the link typically takes you directly to the journal title online.

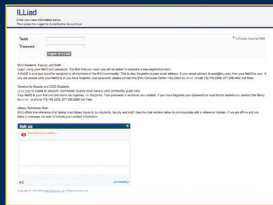


To identify journal titles available in print or online, click the **JOURNALS BY TITLE** link on the homepage.

When you select a database, you will be prompted to enter your BVU NetID and password before gaining access.

# GETTING RESOURCES

Items not available online may be obtained through Interlibrary Loan (ILLiad), a service through which libraries lend items to each other for the use of their patrons. First-time users must register to establish an account on the ILLiad system. From the Library’s homepage, click the “Interlibrary Loan” link on the lefthand menu bar, then log in with your BVU NetID. A “New User Registration” form will appear. We request that you use your BVU e-mail address to ensure prompt delivery of articles to you electronically. Once you have registered on ILLiad you will have a record of all requests placed, be able to track the status of active requests, and view documents requested.



To access this service, click the **INTERLIBRARY LOAN** link on the left menu bar.

## ARTICLES

Before requesting an article through ILLiad, check for full text availability by searching for the journal through the “Journals by Title” link on the homepage. Note that due to copyright laws, you may not request an entire issue of a journal—only individual articles.

Articles will be delivered to you electronically. Materials generally arrive two to three days after your request has been submitted. Requests made during peak periods may take longer. There is no charge for this service.

## BOOKS AND OTHER RETURNABLES

If you wish to borrow circulating materials (books, videos, etc.) owned by the BVU Library, simply request them via the library catalog. After locating your desired item in the catalog, click the “Request” button associated with that item. You will be prompted for your BVU NetID. Items will be mailed to your home address. Please allow three to five days to receive.

The BVU Library can also provide non-owned items. Plan ahead, as it generally takes seven to 10 days to receive an item. There is no charge for this service. However, you are expected to pay return postage costs for items delivered to you. If you prefer, you may request the item via Interlibrary Loan through a local library. This may be faster, since you can pick it up locally.
